

How to handle Muslim Unity

Unity among Muslims is a direct command from God

The Glorious Quran says:

‘And hold fast, all together, by the rope which Allah (stretches for you) and be not divided among yourselves’. (Quran 3:103)

The Quran further says:

‘As for those who divide Their religion and break up into sects, thou hast no part in them in the least: Their affair is with Allah: He will in the end tell them the truth of all that they did: (Quran 6: 159)

God says in this verse that one should disassociate oneself from those who divide their religion and break it up into sect, and further reveals

‘Who is better in speech than one who calls (mankind) to Allah, works righteousness and says, ‘I am of those who bow to Islam (Muslims)

Muslims are single brotherhood and God says:

‘Verily, this brotherhood of yours is a single brotherhood, and I am your Lord and Cherisher: therefore serve Me (and no other)’ Chapter Al-Anbiyah:92

The Prophet Muhammad taught the Muslims that, ‘The Muslim is a brother of another Muslim, he doesn’t oppress him, rather dies he hand him over to the enemy, he doesn’t disappoint him, nor does he humiliate him’

And in (Chapter 22, verse 78), we read: ‘And strive in His cause as ye ought to strive (with sincerity and under discipline). He has chosen you and has imposed no difficulties on you in religion: it is the cult of your father Abraham. It is He who has named you Muslims both before and in this (Revelation): that the Apostle may be a witness for you and ye be witnesses for mankind! So establish regular prayer give regular charity and hold fast to Allah! He is your Protector the Best to protect and the Best to help!

Any disagreement which exists, is something which can be referred to the divine texts:

(Chapter 4, Verse 59) ye who believe! Obey God and obey the Apostle and those charge with authority among you. If ye differ in anything among yourselves refer it to God and His Apostles if ye do believe in God and the Last Day: that is best and most suitable for final determination
