

*Quran uses the word Allah as Lords of the worlds. The one and only God.*

*There are 99 epithets that are considered as His attributes. The Sustainer, The Creator, The Compassionate, The Most Merciful, the King, the Almighty, the All-Seer are some of them.*

It is an obligation for Muslims to start with this verse of Quran

*Bismillah, al-Rahman, al-Rahim* (In the name of Allah, the Compassionate, the Merciful).

Allah – in Arabic are probably two words. ‘al – ilah’ (The God)

The Quran says:

*"Your God is but one God. There is no god other than Him, Compassionate and Merciful. In the creation of the heavens and the earth, in the alternation of night and day, in the ships that ply the seas to the benefit of man, in the water sent down from the heavens to revive the earth after its death, in the different species of animals scattered across the earth, in the rotation of the winds, in the clouds that are subordinate to God's command between heaven and earth, in all of this, there are signs for men who use their intellects." (2:163-164)*

*"He is God, the One other than Whom there is no god, the knower of the hidden and the manifest, the Compassionate, the Merciful. He is God, the One other than Whom there is no god, the Commander, the All-powerful, Pure and Without Defect, the Bestower of Safety, the Protector, the Precious, the Mighty, the Sublime, the Most Elevated. Exempt and purified be He from the partners which they ascribe to Him."(59:22-23)*

*"O Messenger, say: 'He is God, the One, the God Who is free of need for all things and of Whom all beings stand in need. No one is His offspring, and He is not the offspring of anyone, and He has no like or parallel.'" (112:1- 4)*

*"Pure and exalted is thy Lord, God the Powerful and Unique, Who is pure of what men in their ignorance ascribe to Him." (37:180)*

‘Allah is the Light of the heavens and the earth. The example of His light is like a niche within which is a lamp, the lamp is within glass, the glass as if it were a pearly [white] star lit from [the oil of] a blessed olive tree, neither of the east nor of the west, whose oil would almost glow even if untouched by fire. Light upon light.’

‘Who created me, and He [it is who] guides me and it is He who feeds me and gives me drink and when I am ill, it is He who cures me and who will cause me to die and then bring me to life and who I aspire that He will forgive me my sin on the Day of Recompense." [And he said], "My Lord, grant me authority and join me with the righteous. (Surah Ashura) ‘

How can ye reject? The faith in God?—Seeing that ye were without life, and He gave you life. Then will He cause you to die, and will again bring you to life; and again to Him will ye return.
